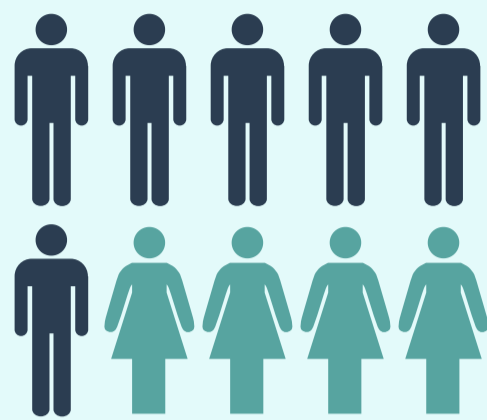


THE HEALTH OF INTEROPERABILITY IN 2019

Six-in-10 said more effective care is the biggest benefit they've seen from interoperability



Two-thirds are exchanging laboratory results electronically



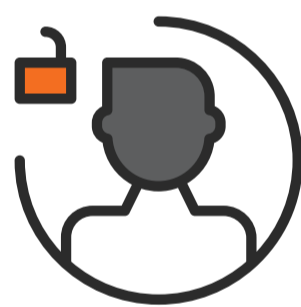
Six-in-10 believe their future plans for interoperability include e-referrals



But, there are financial, technical & legal barriers inhibiting electronic data exchange



Privacy issues & data blocking are the most prevalent legal barriers



Almost 1-in-4 said care coordination was the biggest driver for investment in interoperability tools

3-in-10 said their organization has achieved semantic interoperability (the highest level of interoperability)



3-in-10 are using FHIR as their standards for interoperability



Nine-in-10 believe additional government support would improve interoperability in their jurisdiction
